Eligible individuals must be accepted as a FRESHMAN at an accredited Junior College, College or University and have a parent:

- A. who is an active member of a MCPBA local, or
- B. who died in the line-of-duty while an active member of a MCPBA local, or
- C. who retired in good standing from a MCPBA local.

In order to be considered, an eligible applicant must complete the following requirements:

- A. This application must be completed in full.
- B. Application and required documents (transcripts, SAT results, principal/counselor statement and essay) must be received no later than April 15, 2010.

Scholarship winners will be announced in May, 2010.
